
REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE

Subject:- Posting and transfer of Group B & C officers in CSMRS-Implementation of Supreme Court's judgement dated 31.10.2013 in WP (Civil) No.82/2011 in the matter of Shri T.R. Subramanian & Ors Vs. U.O.I. – status reg.


With reference to the CSMRS Office Order No.15/4/2008-Admn/586 dated 30.03.2015 on the above subject, the Committee held series of meetings and discussed the guidelines on the matter. It has been observed that, CSMRS being a Research Institute and having its centre in Delhi only, the Group 'B' and 'C' employees of CSMRS are not transferred out of the organisation. However, for any internal transfer takes place in CSMRS, the following procedures are recommended:

1. For the officials posted in the sensitive posts (such as General section, Procurement Section etc.) maximum tenure should be two/three years and they can be posted back only after a period of cooling off period of two/three years.
2. Such transfers should be made only in consultation with the concerned Group Heads and Divisional Heads.

In addition to above, all CVC guidelines in the matter, issued from time to time may also be followed.
