- On February 8, 1944, in the legislative assembly during the debate on the Lifting of Ban on Employment of Women on Underground Work in Coal Mines, Ambedkar said:

“It is for the first time that I think in any industry the principle has been established of equal pay for equal work irrespective of the sex.”
