

- The Green Building movement was pioneered in Great Britain with the rating system called BREEAM (Building Research Establishment's Environmental Assessment Method) which was first launched in 1990. This system was later adopted in the U.S when the US Green Building Council was formed in 1998.
- In India, this movement was adopted by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) in the early part of this decade. They formed the Indian Green Building Council which is actively involved in promoting the Green Building concept in India.

 **Highlights:**


- ❑ Maharashtra has topped 1st position and has 334 LEED-certified green buildings.
- ❑ Karnataka ranked 2nd position with 232 LEED-certified green buildings
- ❑ Tamil Nadu was in the top position last year
- ❑ The Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) defines a green building in India with more than 5,400 green building projects, amounting to 7 billion sq.ft. of space in about 18 years is coming up by 2022
